There may also be the opportunity to be involved with some of our introductory music classes for young children.

In addition to the established Conservatory and University teaching there is the opportunity to assist in developing new vocal initiatives both at the conservatory and university. The successful applicant will be joining a team of energetic and highly motivated teachers who not only love to teach, but enjoy collaborating with their colleagues and students to produce high profile recitals and concerts in our community.
