The COSI 2015 Music Research Workshop is a training course on qualitative and quantitative research methods in music performance, with an inviting immersion in Italian music and culture. It culminates in the COSI Symposium on July 19th, when participants can formally present their work.

For in-career performers, educators, and graduate students at the master's and doctoral levels, this course allows you to confidently meet the ever-increasing emphasis on research studies in the arts, research components to grant applications, and a new academic standard for article submissions to journals in our field.

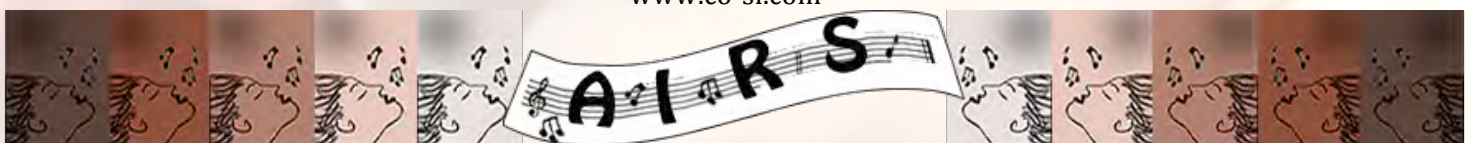
